

DIRECTIONS TO PINE BLUFF

Take the expressway from Liverpool, exit at the first Goulburn Exit (155km).

Follow the main road into Goulburn. At the second major set of traffic lights turn right into Goldsmith Street to Crookwell. Proceed along Goldsmith Road and turn right at the second roundabout to Crookwell (42km).

Continue 10km past the village of Binda turning left to Bigga (59km).

Follow the road for 26km. After crossing the third wooden bridge you will be travelling up a hill. At the top of the hill turn right onto Greenmantle Road – you are now on a dirt road. If you miss this turn you end up at Bigga 1km past Greenmantle Road.

Follow Greenmantle Road for 20kms until you reach a gate on the right marked “TGS Pine Bluff”. Please ensure that the gate is closed after entering or departing the property. There is a woolshed on your right near the gate.

Leave Greenmantle Road, follow the track for 9kms until the campus is reached, pass through a second grid after 800 metres and further kilometre will bring you to a steep escarpment with the river below. The track winds down to the river and the campus is reached by travelling west along the track near the shore.

Allow 5 hours travelling time.

The School is responsible for the maintenance of the 9km road approaching the campus. However, after heavy or prolonged rain, slippery conditions may exist. If you are concerned, please ring prior to your arrival 4835 2231.

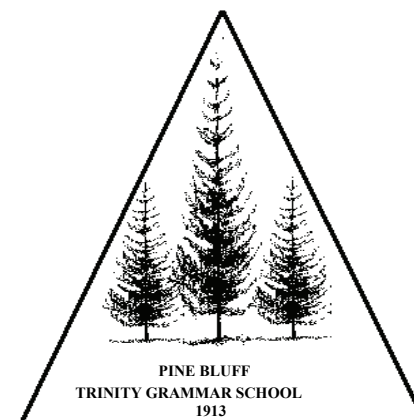

1 Waterproof outer shell rain jacket & pants - no ponchos

1 Set of thermal pants & shirt (light under-garment style)

1 Warm hat (beanie)

1 Wind jacket or parka in addition to a raincoat

2 Warm jumpers - wool, Polartec or 100% polyester only

Shoes

2 Pairs of comfortable shoes - joggers, inside-sneakers, slippers, Ugg boots, Crocs etc

1 Pair work/hiking boots - cadet issue boots are fine

1 Pair of lace up, covered shoes for water activities

No sandals or thongs of any form

EXTRA EQUIPMENT

1 sturdy day pack suitable for hiking

1 sleeping bag with cover suitable for camp conditions i.e. Summer +5 or Winter – 5 ratings

1 head torch with spare batteries - no sports brands as they will NOT last the camp

1 knife, fork & spoon set, plastic plate, bowl, mug and tea towel for camping

2 one litre water bottles minimum or similar

1 whistle on a cord

1 lunch box

5 garbage bags - Glad extra strong extra large
