Temporary Alternative drop off arrangements from Week 4



We look forward to welcoming our Year 7 to 11 students back onsite for their learning from Monday 25th October. This is likely to result in an increase in traffic due to the current guidelines outlined by the government. After consultation with Inner West Council and Traffic & Highway Patrol Command, Trinity has been granted permission to provide a temporary alternative traffic management plan for the return of students. Please read through the Plan below and we would like to emphasise that the most important aspect regarding student drop off and pick up is safety.

Temporary Change to our Traffic Management Plan

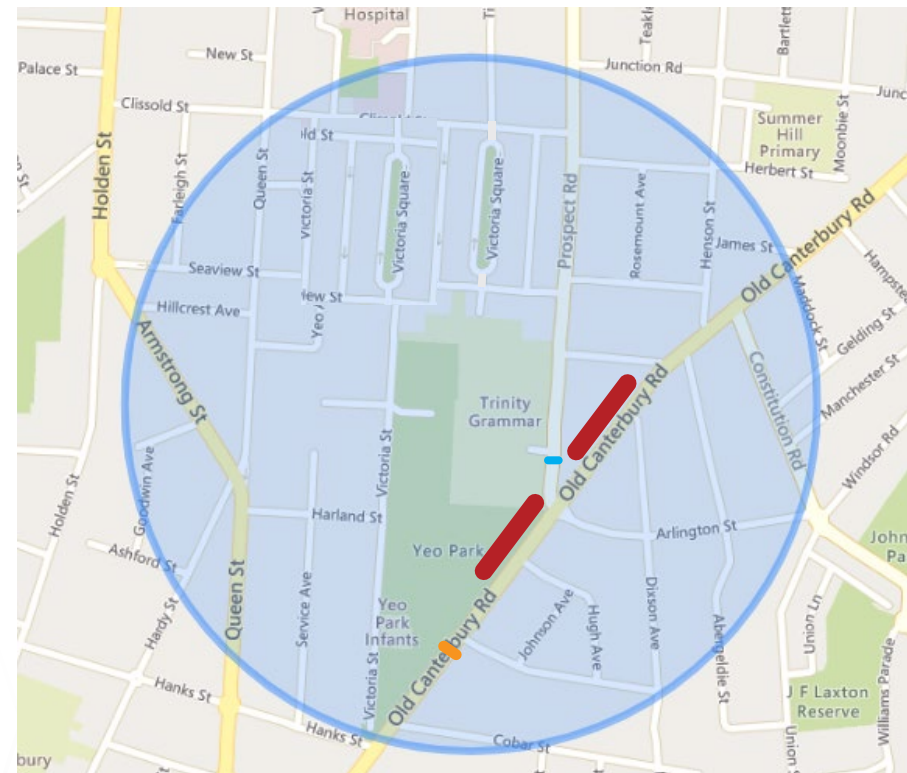
- Be Patient, Be Calm, Don't Rush and allow extra time
- Pull off the main road carefully and completely to drop off
- Students are encouraged to take the short walk to school to assist with the management and flow of traffic
- Follow the flow of the traffic and merge back in carefully
- Older boys should look after our younger students and walk up together
- Remember to drop off in a safe location that provides a safe route for your son to walk to school, crossing either no roads or only small low traffic streets
- Always park legally



Students must have their bags with them on the floor of the car or next to them on the seat. They are not to go to the boot to get their bag.

The map below shows our suggested drop off locations and a circle that indicates 500m from the centre of the school.
