Ethos

Qualification Pathways

There are several patterns of study and a wide range of subjects available to Trinity students in Years 11 to 12, depending on their post school goals.

- ▲ **Higher School Certificate (HSC)** – the traditional pre-tertiary credential for students in New South Wales. All Australian universities accept this credential.
- ▲ **International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB Diploma)** – Internationally recognised, the IB Diploma is an academically challenging and balanced programme for students in Years 11 and 12, preparing them for success at university and beyond.
- ▲ **Trinity Vocational Academic Course (TVAC)** – Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses, allow students to engage in and maximise their individual talents. As they acquire a range of technical, practical, personal, and organisational abilities, students develop industry-recognised skills for the working world.

Co-Curricular:

Trinity offers unparalleled creative arts, music, cadets and sports programmes. Trinity is one of only nine schools globally to be accredited as a World Academy of Sport Athlete Friendly Education Centre. Sport is compulsory for all students from years 3 to 12.
